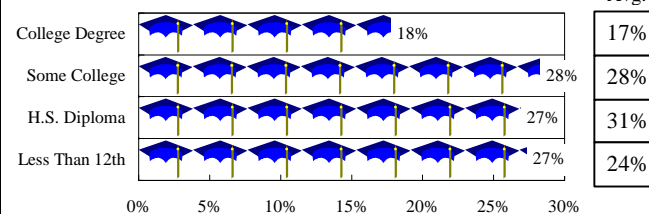

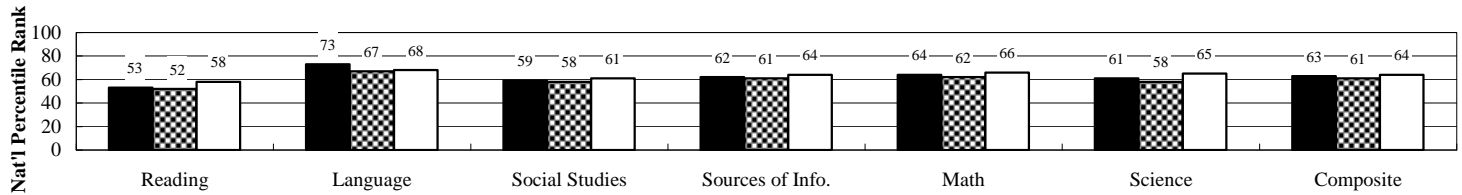

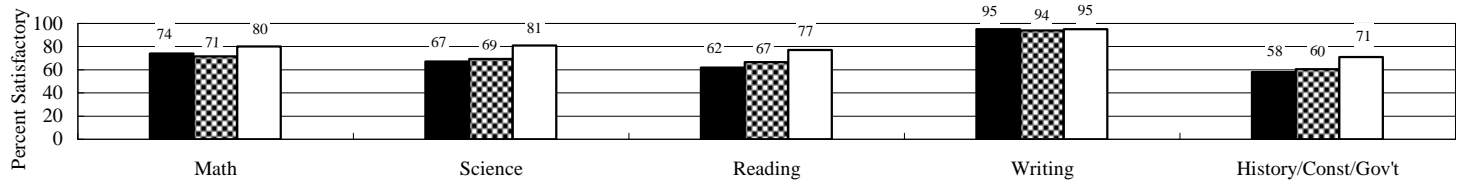
3rd Grade Iowa Test of Basic Skills

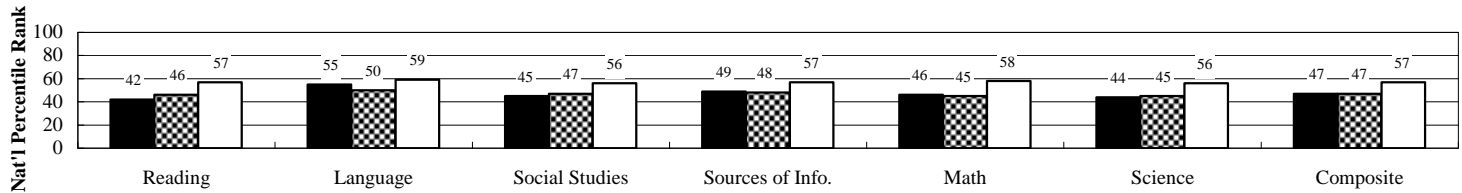
5th Grade Oklahoma Core Curriculum Test

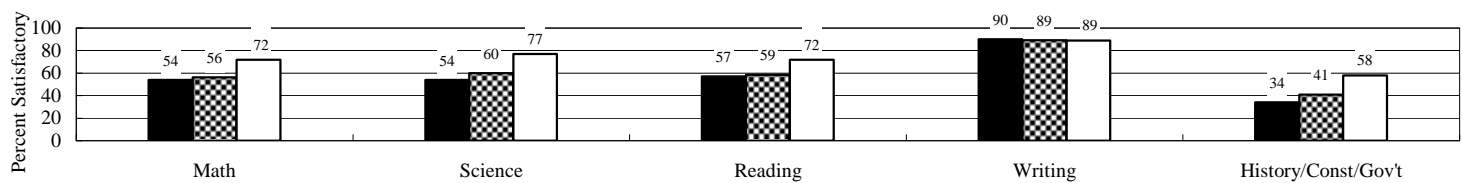
7th Grade Iowa Test of Basic Skills

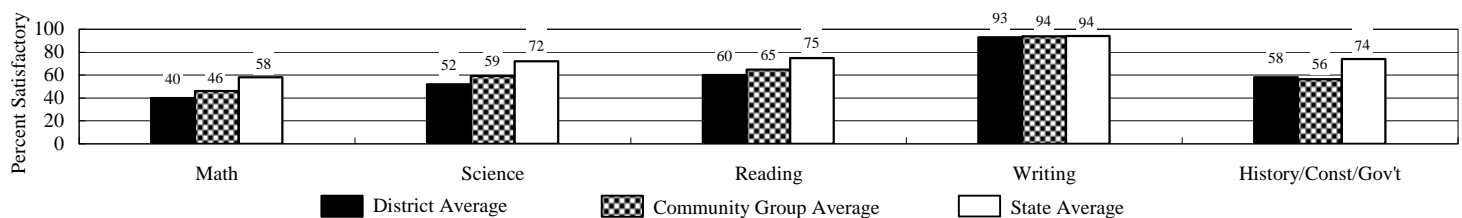
8th Grade Oklahoma Core Curriculum Test
