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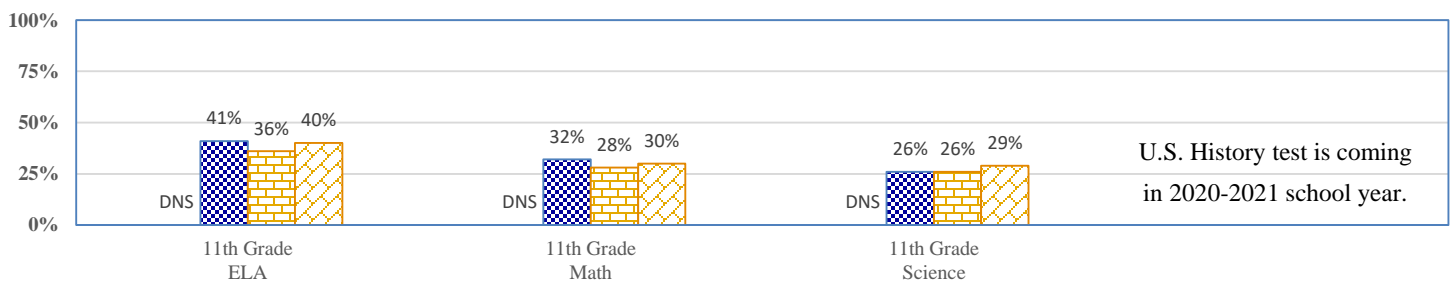
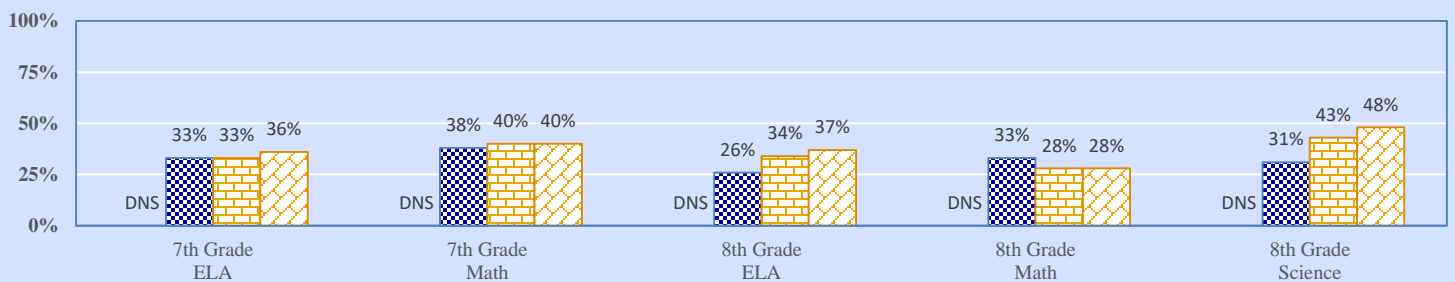
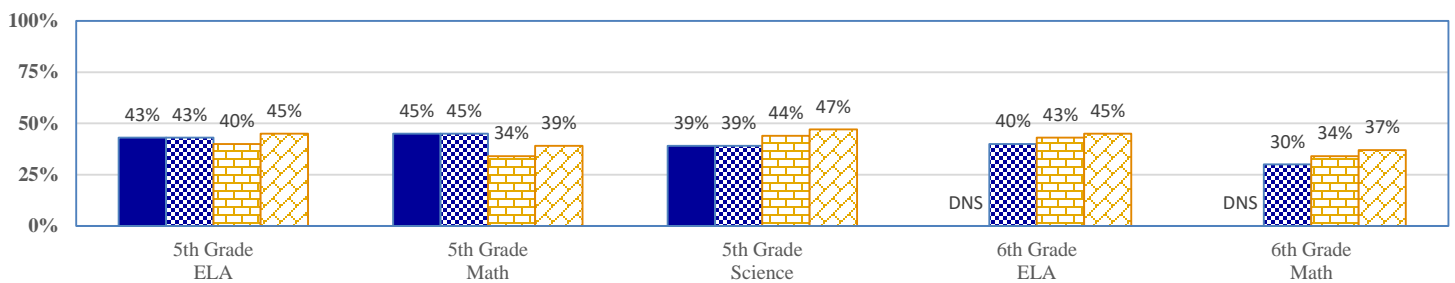
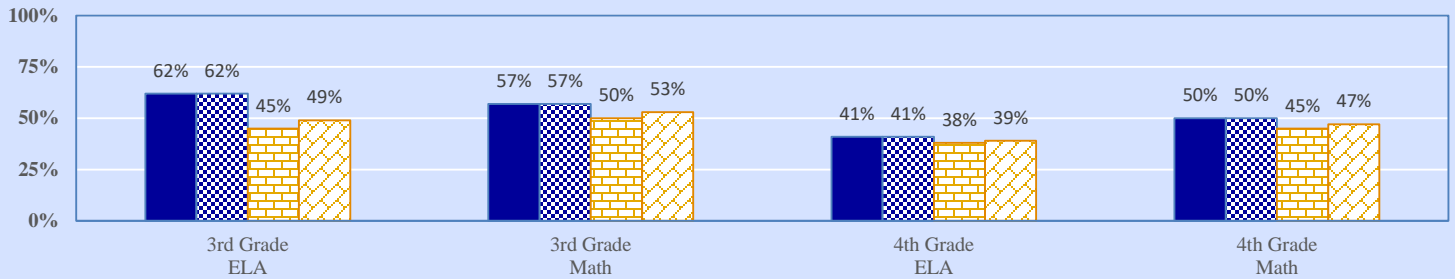
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# 2018-19 Student Performance *(Regular Education Students, Full Academic Year at This Site)*

**% of Students Scoring Proficient and Above by Grade and Subject**



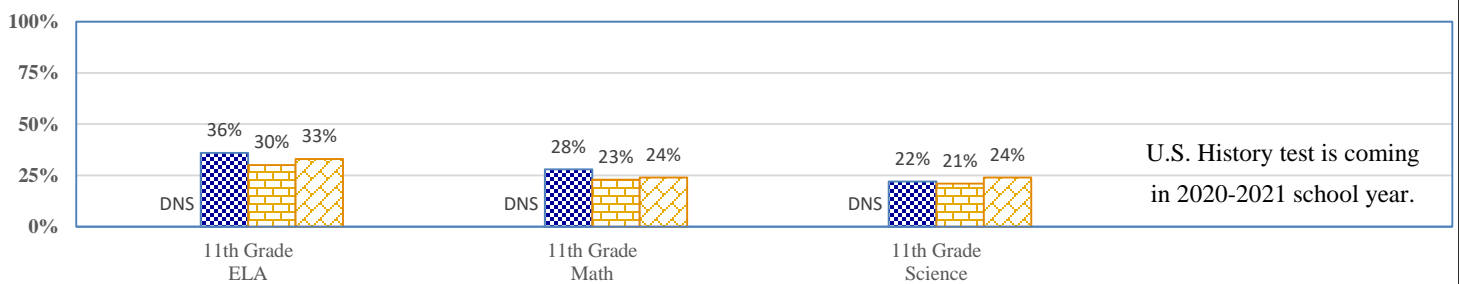
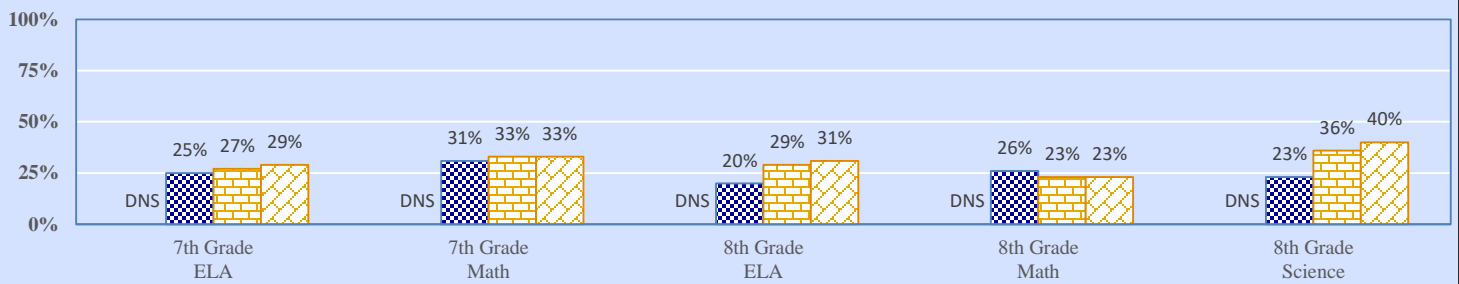
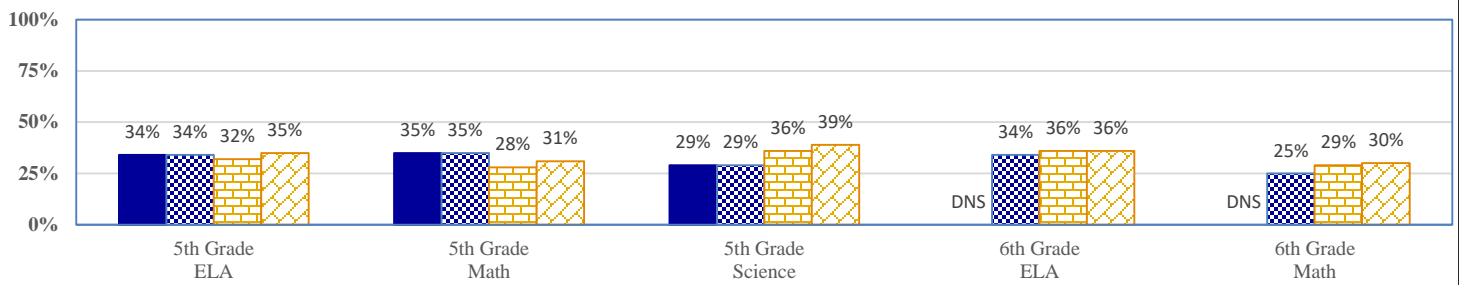
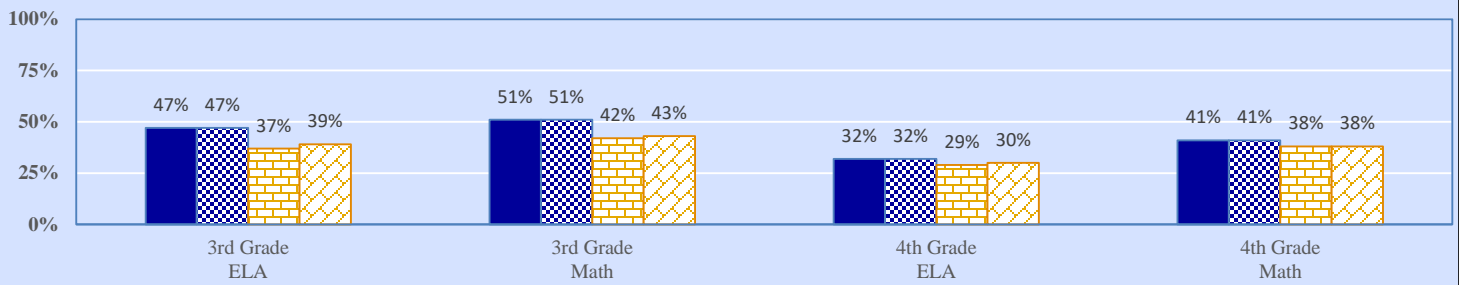
